Kid classes (510-514) to be judged at 2.30 p.m. on Saturday

All other classes to be judged on Sunday

The Show is only open for CAE Negative goats. Before goats are brought into the marquee, a certificate issued during the previous 12 months is to be shown to the Steward and the earmarks of the goats checked.

Kids to be booked in by 1.00 p.m. on Saturday.

Goats in milk to be booked in by 5.30 p.m. on Saturday and milked out by 6.30 p.m.

On Sunday, milking trials to be completed by 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m.

Goatlings to be booked in by 9.30 a.m. on Sunday. Late arrivals will be disqualified.

Best Kid and Best Reserve Kid, judged on Saturday to remain on the Showground for Best in Show judging on Sunday.

THE GOAT CLASSES ARE HELD UNDER THE RULES, REGULATIONS AND RECOGNITION OF THE BRITISH GOAT SOCIETY. ALL EXHIBITS IN THESE CLASSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE BRITISH GOAT SOCIETY, AS IN THE OWNERSHIP AND IN THE NAME OF THE EXHIBITOR, THE REGISTERED NAME AND NUMBER BEING QUOTED ON THE ENTRY FORM (ALSO THE KIDDING DATE FOR GOATS IN MILK). ALL GOATS IN MILK MUST BE KIDDED OR ABORTED A MINIMUM OF 30 DAYS PREVIOUS TO THE DATE OF THE SHOW.

If there are five or more entries of each breed in any of the joint classes, those classes may be split and judged separately.

- Class 500 FEMALE GOAT**, that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, entered in the Saanen or British Saanen Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 501 FEMALE GOAT**, that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, entered in the Toggenburg or British Toggenburg Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 502 FEMALE GOAT**, that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, entered in the British Alpine Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 503 FEMALE GOAT**, that has borne a kid, any age, in milk, entered in the Anglo-Nubian Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 504 FEMALE GOAT**, that has borne a kid, any age, in milk. Any other variety.

- Class 505 GOATLING**, that has not borne a kid, over one but not exceeding two years, entered in the Saanen or British Saanen Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 506 GOATLING**, that has not borne a kid, over one but not exceeding two years, entered in the Toggenburg or British Toggenburg Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 507 GOATLING**, that has not borne a kid, over one but not exceeding two years, entered in the British Alpine Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 508 GOATLING**, that has not borne a kid, over one but not exceeding two years, entered in the Anglo-Nubian Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 509 GOATLING**, that has not borne a kid, over one but not exceeding two years, any other variety.

- Class 510 FEMALE KID**, over two months but not exceeding one year, entered in the Saanen or British Saanen Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 511 FEMALE KID**, over two months but not exceeding one year, entered in the Toggenburg or British Toggenburg Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 512 FEMALE KID**, over two months but not exceeding one year, entered in the British Alpine Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 513 FEMALE KID**, over two months but not exceeding one year, entered in the Anglo-Nubian Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 514 FEMALE KID**, over two months but not exceeding one year. Any other variety.

- Class 515 MILKING COMPETITION**, for Goats entered in the Saanen or the British Saanen Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 516 MILKING COMPETITION**, for Goats entered in the Toggenburg or British Toggenburg Sections of the Herd Book.
- Class 517 MILKING COMPETITION**, for Goats entered in the British Alpine Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 518 MILKING COMPETITION**, for Goats entered in the Anglo-Nubian Section of the Herd Book.
- Class 519 MILKING COMPETITION**, for Goats of any other variety.

- Ch70(T61) THE NOVICE CHALLENGE CUP**, presented by Mrs HF Boxer and a Champion Rosette, for the **Best Goat in Milk** with a well-shaped udder, sired by a pedigree male.
- Ch71(T58) THE SHENDISH CHALLENGE CUP**, presented by Mrs R Gordon-Wilson and a Champion Rosette, for the **Best Goatling**, registered with the BGS.
- Ch72(T59) THE MYSIE CHALLENGE CUP**, presented by Mr IG Aitchison and a Champion Rosette, for the **Best Kid**, over five months but not exceeding one year, registered with the BGS.
- Ch73(T60) THE BAVINGTON CHALLENGE CUP**, presented by Miss A Bell, and a Champion Rosette for the **British Alpine Goat** gaining the highest number of points in the Milking Trials. Must also be entered in Inspection Class. Any goat disqualified in the Trials is ineligible.
- Ch74(T57) THE ALETSCORN CHALLENGE CUP**, presented by the late Dr Violet Rendell and a Champion Rosette, for the **Champion Exhibit** registered with the BGS.

- (e) Certificate of Merit for the Best British Milker that has borne a kid.
