Foals and three-year-old fillies with foals are not eligible. Stallions and colts, two years old and over, must be in possession of a Ministry of Agriculture or a Breed Society Licence. Handlers of stallions and colts must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Handlers aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured British standard skull caps or riding hats.

Exhibited by a full adult member of The National Pony Society on production, in the ring, of their Membership Card. Winners are entitled to compete in the NPS Mountain and Moorland Kilmannan Stud In Hand Championship to be held at their Summer Championship Show in Malvern, providing they send to the NPS secretariat, the relevant entry fee and qualification card provided with the Silver Medal Rosette. If the Champion has previously qualified then the Reserve Champion may receive the qualification card (provided that the exhibitor is a full adult member of the NPS). MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND PONIES (RIDDEN)

Class 74 FELL, HIGHLAND, DALES, WELSH SEC D, any sex, 4 years old or older.

Class 75 WELSH SEC B AND WELSH SEC C, any sex, 4 years old or older.

Class 76 NEW FOREST, CONNEMARA, any sex, 4 years old or older.

Class 77 DARTMOOR, EXMOOR, SHETLAND AND WELSH SEC A, any sex, 4 years old or older.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE REGISTERED IN THEIR RESPECTIVE STUD BOOKS (PART BREDS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE) AND BOTH BREED AND REGISTRATION NUMBER MUST BE GIVEN ON THE ENTRY FORM.

Riders of small breed stallions must have attained their 12th birthday and large breed riders must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Spurs are not allowed in any Ridden Class judged under NPS Rules. No lead rein competitors may enter these classes.

THE KINGSFORD MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND RIDDEN PONY OF THE YEAR CHAMPIONSHIP. Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Breed Societies. Rider any age (please see Rule 7, page 4 of the 2004 Rule Book). The highest placed small breed exhibit (Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B) and the highest placed large breed exhibit (Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D) not already qualified within the first three places and in possession of a P(UK) Summer Competition Card will qualify. The Champion of the Ridden Mountain & Moorland section will also qualify for the P(UK) COOPER SERIES FERNDAL RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND CHAMPIONSHIP to be held at the Summer Championships on the 17th to 21st August 2004. In the event that the Champion has qualified the qualification may pass down to the Reserve Champion.

Ch23 CHAMPIONSHIP ROSETTES, for the Champion and Reserve Champion.

Sp51 NPS MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WAHL (UK) LTD RIDDEN SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE CHAMPIONSHIP. Ponies Association (UK) Affiliation Number 004/AFF/078

This Show is a qualifier for the Ponies (UK) 2004 Summer Championship Show, to be held on the 17th – 21st August 2004 at the East of England Showground, Peterborough.

TO QUALIFY, horses/ponies **MUST** be registered with Ponies Association (UK) before qualification. Competition cards will be issued free of charge from the Ponies Association (UK) Office on completion of registration of horse/pony. Riders **MUST** become 'A' Members or Junior/Senior Riders Club Members before entry into the Summer Championships is lodged.

QUALIFICATION, the highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first three places in each class and in possession of a P(UK) Summer Competition Card will qualify.

LEE-SMITH HOME PRODUCED SUMMER SERIES CHAMPIONSHIPS. All classes which are affiliated to Ponies Association (UK) and held before 31st July 2004 will automatically be qualifiers for the Lee-Smith Home Produced National Championships, held at the Ponies (UK) Summer Show. It is the responsibility of eligible competitors to apply for the Lee-Smith Competition Card from Ponies (UK) and present the card to the Judge or Steward at the time of qualification.
